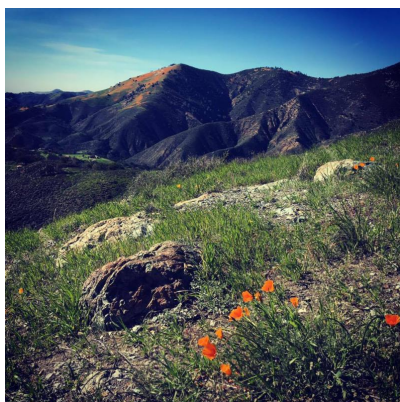

Mentorship: Support to Success Applications Due: May 13

The Frieda C. Fox Family Foundation (FCF) [Junior Board](#) is excited to invite you to apply for their third collaborative grant process. The Junior Board, a group of Fox family members and friends ages 8-21, are an integral part of fulfilling the Foundation's mission. Funded by the FCF Board of Trustees, this grant focuses on nonprofits and their programs that **provide youth with supportive adult mentors.**

The members of the Junior Board recognize that a key ingredient in the recipe for youth success is the presence of positive adult role models. Youth who have relationships with supportive adults are more likely to make the transition to adulthood more smoothly and have better outcomes than their peers in all development areas.

The Junior Board will accept grant applications from **\$500-\$3,000** to support nonprofits and their programs that connect a supportive adult with youth to help them build a positive relationship, develop their interests, learn new skills, and connect with the resources they need. Programming may focus on technology, advocacy, social justice, college access, or other areas of youth development. Submitted applications must demonstrate:

- A small mentor to student ratio.
- Primary focus on youth in 6th-12th grades.
- Consistency and impact with the population served.
- An adequate number of hours/weeks of programming.
- Training for mentors and continued monitoring of the mentor/mentee relationship.

- Finalists Notified: Late May
- Site Visits: June-August
- Grant Notifications: Late September

Youth Innovation in Action Grant Letters of Inquiry Due: May 13



The Frieda C. Fox Foundation and its Board of Directors is excited to invite you to apply for the Youth Innovation in Action Grant. We know that young people are willing and able to be changemakers at home, in their schools, and in their communities. **This youth-centered grant intends to empower youth to exercise their problem-solving and leadership abilities by making positive changes in their community.**

The Youth Innovation in Action Grant asks youth to be the facilitators or solutions to the problems that they find most important to address for them and their peers. **Submitted proposals must:**

- Identify a problem youth face in their community that affects their ability to thrive.
- Offer a solution to the problem that could easily be replicated.
- Include a video description of the program by current youth participants in their own words.
- Demonstrate youth leadership in at least one of several areas: program implementation, on the board/administration, through alumni participation, or training for youth leaders in the program.
- Be submitted by a nonprofit organization recognized by the IRS as a 501(c)3 charity or a government entity qualified to receive foundation grants.

- Be located in California, with preference given to Los Angeles County.
- Be willing to be visited by the Foundation's staff and/or members of the board.

All ideas for meaningful change are welcome, both new and those already in progress.

Preference will be given to proposals that provide a youth-created solution that can be replicated and is innovative, encourages intergenerational collaboration, and emphasizes community-based resources and assets.

Grant requests should reflect the scope of your proposed work and can range from **\$1,000-\$25,000**. After submitting Letters of Inquiry, finalists will be chosen to submit full applications and receive site visits. Successful proposals will receive up to \$25,000 in grant funds to be used in 2016-2017.

- Finalists Announced: Late May
- Full Application DUE: Late June
- Site Visits: June-August
- Grant Notifications: Late September
