



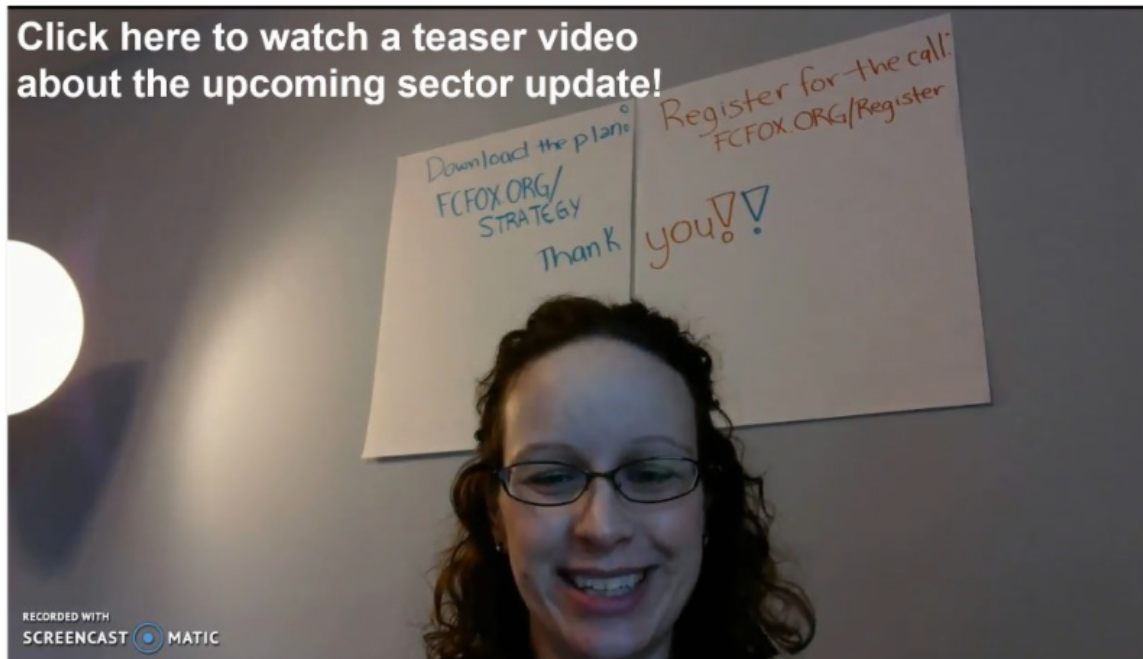

Transforming Family Philanthropy Retreat

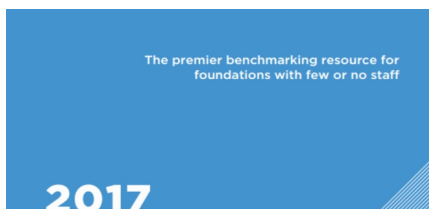
[Resource Generation](#) is hosting a retreat, called [Transforming Family Philanthropy](#), April 27-30 in Petaluma, CA!

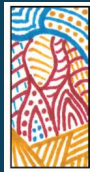
