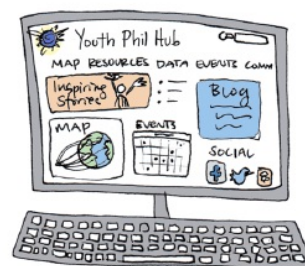
2. [rolePLAY](#)

5. **YPC Hits the Road!**

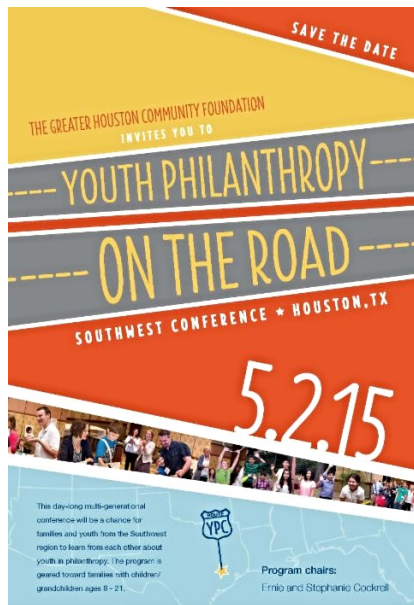

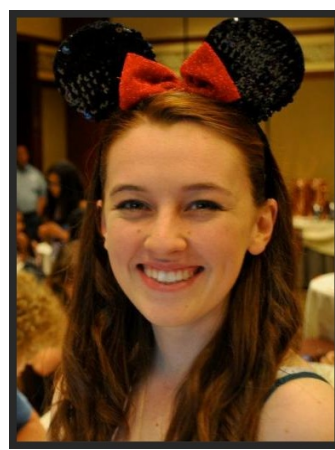
