What's it like to be on a Junior Board? Leadership Team Member Brendan Adam's Blog Post Shares!



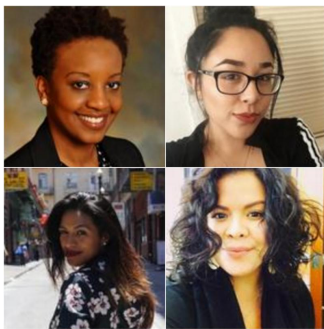

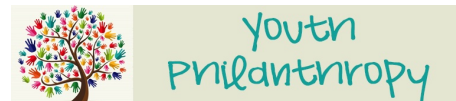

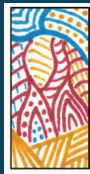
