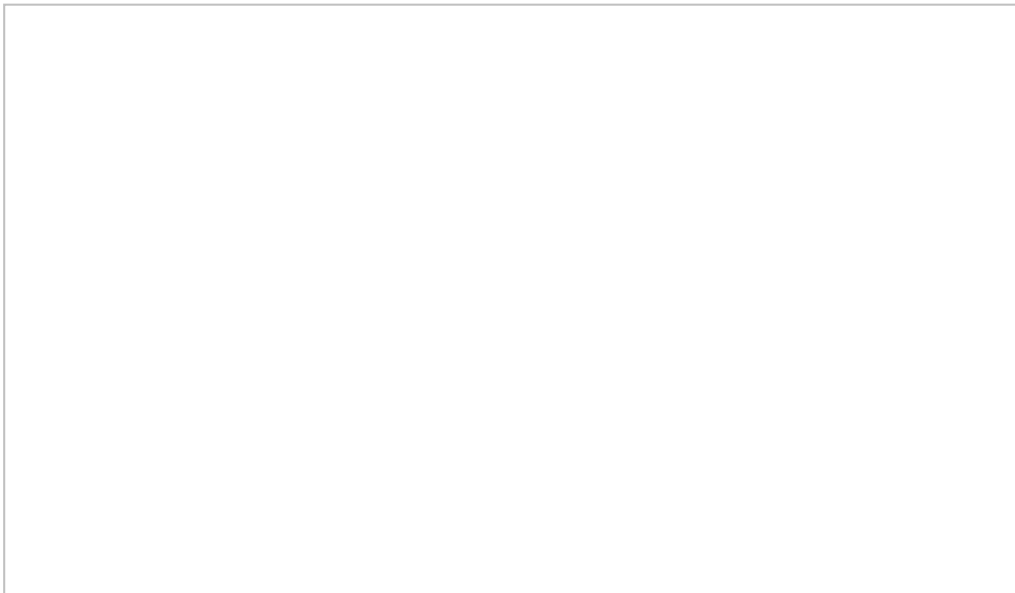


Not Too Late to Register!
