Emily Falconer is exploring the world to make sense of the seventeen [Global Goals for Sustainable Development](#) the [United Nations](#) has recently released.

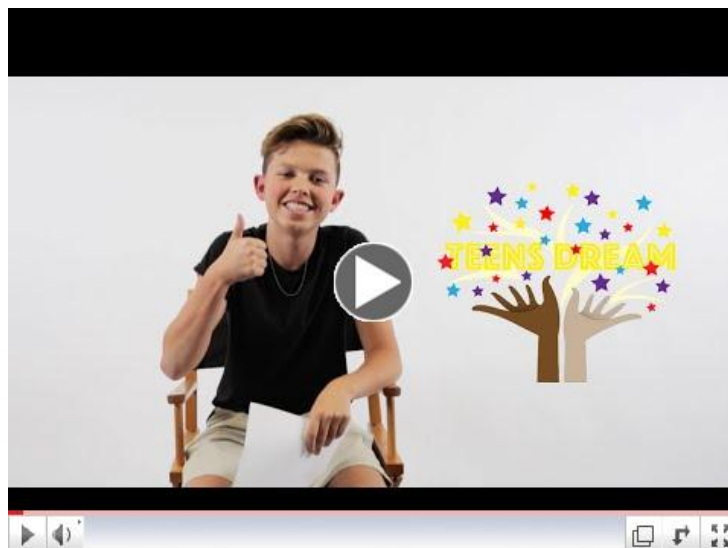

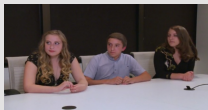
